- 5. A statement that the party making the complaint, in good faith believes that the disputed use is not authorized by the copyright owner, it's agent, or the law;
- 6. A statement, made under penalty of perjury, that the information in the notice is accurate and that the complaining party is the copyright owner or authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner's behalf.

Your full name, mailing address, email address and contact number along with a statement that you consent to the jurisdiction of the Federal District Court in the judicial district where your address is located if your address is in the United States, or if your address is outside the United States, and that you will accept service of process from the agent, party or person submitting the notice.
