South Central Communications (SCC) is pleased to be a contributing supporter of education and has set aside a sum of money to be used for educational scholarships. This scholarship fund is for the benefit of SCC Members.

SCC will award two (2) \$2,000.00 scholarships for two (2) consecutive years for a total eligible award of \$4,000.00 each. These scholarships will be chosen by an SCC Selection Committee.

Eligibility:

Each applicant must:

- Be a Non-Traditional Student. (must meet one of the following: 1. Delayed enrollment into post-secondary education; 2. Attends college part-time; 3. Works full time; 4. Is financially independent for financial aid purposes; 5. Has dependents other than a spouse; 6. Is a single parent; or 7. Does not have a high school Diploma/GED).
- Be a Member of SCC with active landline telephone service on the date of the initial award of the scholarship.
- Be committed to using education to better your life and that of your family and/or community.

Terms:

- **Submission deadline is 5:00 PM on Friday, February 11, 2022.**
- Applicant must be accepted by an accredited two- or four-year college or university or Trade/Vocational School.
- Payments of grant shall be paid directly to the registrar's office or Trade/Vocational Institution in the name of the recipient, upon submission of verified full time or (12 credit hours) registration at an approved school.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender or disability.
- The selection criteria are based on the following:
 1. Clearly defined career goals and objectives.
 2. Essay
 3. Dedication to positively impact your personal life, employment, family and community.
 4. Community involvement
 5. Strength of Recommendations
- Scholarships are in the amount of \$2000.00 for two (2) consecutive years for a total eligible award of \$4000.00 as long as student is enrolled and participating in the same program. Termination of student's school enrollment will result in cancellation of the award and any remaining funds will not be disbursed.
- Winners will be posted on the SCC website (SoCen.com).

Applications Instructions:

- Complete the scholarship application in full using the official SCC Adult Application form by Friday, February 11, 2022. If any information is incomplete, the application will be rejected.
- Prepare a 300-word essay (12 point font, double-spaced with one inch margins, and full name in upper left corner with the title of your essay centered) on the following topic:
 - Tell us about yourself, your career ambitions and experiences(s) that have shaped who you are or guided you to the career path you've chosen. Please describe how receiving this award will positively impact your personal life and the community in which you reside.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a local community leader (example: Elected Official, Local Business Leader, Employer, etc.).
- Application must be signed in pen where indicated.
- All materials, including application, recommendation letter, and essay, must be submitted electronically via email to scholarship@socen.com and **must be typed, scanned and submitted together.**
