SC Broadband is pleased to be a contributing supporter of education and has set aside a sum of money to be used for educational scholarships. This scholarship fund is for the benefit of SC Broadband Members and their family.

SC Broadband will award eleven (11) \$1,000.00 Academic Scholarships. These scholarships will be chosen by an SC Broadband Selection Committee.

Eligibility:

Each applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior.
- Be a dependent residing in an SC Broadband Member household with active service.
- Have at least a 2.0 ("C") grade point average (GPA).

Terms:

- Submission deadline is 5:00 PM on Friday, February 16, 2024.
- Applicant must be accepted by an accredited two or four-year college or university.
- Payments of grant shall be paid directly to the registrar's office in the name of the recipient, upon submission of verified full time (12 credit hours) registration at an approved school.
- Scholarship may be deferred for religious mission or military service.
- Scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender, or disability.
- The selection criteria are based on the following:
 - 1. Educational achievement
 - 2. Essay
 - 3. Involvement in activities, honors, and awards
 - 4. Career goals
 - 5. Strength of Recommendations
- Scholarships are in the amount of \$1,000.00, awarded on a one-time basis and are not renewable.
 Termination of student's school enrollment will result in cancellation of the award and any remaining funds will not be disbursed.

Applications Instructions:

- Complete the scholarship application in full using the official SC Broadband application form by February 16, 2024. If any information is incomplete, the application will be rejected.
- Prepare a 300-word essay (12 point font, double-spaced with one inch margins, and full name in upper left corner with the title of your essay centered) on the following topic:
 - Tell us about yourself, your career ambitions and an experience(s) that have shaped who you are or guided you to the career path you've chosen. Additionally, if your goal is to return to rural Utah, please include that in your essay as well.
- Submit an Educator Statement completed by a current high school teacher or guidance counselor.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a local community leader other than an educator (example: Elected Official, Local Business Leader, Church Leader, etc.).
- Include your High School transcript with the most recent semester (7 semesters). Transcript must be signed by authorized personnel but does not have to be sealed.
- Application must be signed in pen where indicated.
- All materials, including application, recommendation letter, educator statement and essay, must be submitted electronically via email to scholarships@scbroadband.com and <u>must be typed, scanned and</u> <u>submitted together as one document.</u>
